2016 REGIONAL TEACHER OF THE YEAR NOMINATIONS

Under the direction of the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Missouri State University and the Southwest Regional Professional Development Center, in cooperation with the Southwest Center for Educational Excellence and the Greater Ozarks Cooperating School Districts will be hosting the Southwest Missouri Master Teacher Regional Summit to be held on Thursday, October 6, 2016. The Summit will be held at the Bass Pro Shops' John A. & Genny Morris Conservation Center, 600 West Sunshine in Springfield. The purpose of the Summit is to collect information from the regions' best cooperating teachers on ways to improve the student teaching process. Colleges and Universities in Southwest Missouri will be providing names of outstanding cooperating teachers for consideration for the Summit and from that group, 21 will be selected and invited to participate. If any secondary faculty members would like to nominate an outstanding cooperating teacher for this summit, they can submit that to Dr. Russ Brock, Coordinator of Programs for the Southwest Regional Professional Development Center no later than Friday, September 2, 2016.
