UHC 399 HONORS INTERNSHIP/APPRENTICESHIP REGISTRATION FORM

Missouri State University Honors College

This 3 credit hour course provides students with the opportunity to obtain practical and theoretical knowledge in a variety of career fields through the completion of a supervised internship experience. Students will secure an internship opportunity that will serve as a learning laboratory where they may apply what they are learning in the classroom, observe and reflect upon organizational operations, and synthesize their academic and professional experiences by completing an academic project incorporating what they learned during their experience.

Students are expected to complete a minimum of 45 hours of work with an approved organization. Individual course instructors have the right to require additional hours. Course instructors must be a faculty member with expertise in the field in which you plan to work.

The nature of individual projects will vary by academic discipline, but students should be prepared to satisfy the following expectations:

- Course instructors will help students to develop and articulate guidelines, expectations, goals, and learning outcomes for their course.
- Course instructors will require students to prepare for their internship experience by reviewing relevant textbooks, journals, or completing research that will help students to understand the sector that you they entering and the key theories or methodologies involved in their work.
- Students will submit written progress reports to their course instructor (suggested every 3 weeks) that highlight all tasks being performed, a summary of what the student has accomplished and learned, an assessment of organizational operations, an outline of any challenges being confronted, and a preview of future tasks and responsibilities. This is an ideal time for students to ask questions and to seek feedback from their course instructor.
- Students will submit a written academic project or portfolio piece demonstrating
 what they have learned. This might take the form of a case study, policy
 proposal, training manual, methodological discussion, lab report, or other
 creative assessments. Students may generally expect to write 5-10 pages,
 depending upon the academic discipline.
