GUEST SPEAKER

- Q and A session with Clif Smart, Matt Morris, and Zora Mulligan.
 - Beginning next fall, new Missouri undergraduate students who are eligible for the Pell Grant won't pay any tuition or fees at Missouri State University.
 - This is a "gap filler" program meaning the MoState Access Award will cover all tuition and fees that aren't covered by other scholarships and grants.

EXECUTIVE REPRESENTATION REPORTS

- Plan to stick with the Springfield Public Schools Calendar. Currently approved Thanksgiving week, 2023 off for students. Staff/Faculty will be in office for Monday and Tuesday of that week.
- Paws to the Polls presentation. Students can no longer use a student I.D. to vote. Will need a Missouri Identification. Esports approved as a certificate.
- Benefits open enrollment November 1, 2022, through December 1, 2022. Walking competition held from October 1, 2022, through October 31, 2022. VSP contract renewed for four years. A noncredit fee waiver will include fitness classes but not gym membership.
- Cybersecurity training has just been released and is required for all employees. Grammarly pilot is currently underway. All computers will need to have Windows 11 by October 14, 2025.
 Mobile App for bear pass will be implemented soon. My MSU will be going through an upgrade in the coming months. A major upgrade day is scheduled for January 23, 2023.
