- Executive Budget New fiscal year budgets are looking to increase students fee, parking and childcare expenses. The cost of living has gone up 30% over the last 11 years. MSU cost of living increases have only gone up around 19%.
- Health Care and Benefits Received the Mercer report for 2021. Overall, the benefits were received positively. Many of the issues are currently being addressed such as short-term disability and identify protections coverage.
- Shared Leave One new case was approved by email. Met with HR to discuss what changes could be implemented in the future.
- Student Government Discussed Project Heal. Passed a resolution in support of Staff Senates remote work/flex time resolution.
