Article _____. Homecoming

Section ____: Pumping

- A. Pumping shall be defined by this body as the act of using tissue paper rolled and glued to a float or other surface for the purpose of decoration in order to be presented in the Homecoming parade. This includes but is not limited to rolling paper into a ball, rolling into pencil shaped rolls, and “finger pumping”,
- B. Pumping shall not be used by any Interfraternity Council Chapters on any part of their float, car entry or any other Homecoming Week projects or event materials.
- C. If an IFC chapter participates in the act of pumping for homecoming, a \$750 fine will be incurred.
