#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE INTERFRATERNITY COUNCIL HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

Section 1: IFC has determined that a "no-bid period" be enacted beginning January 16th and ending January 24th, and that the official recruitment period run from January 25th to February 3rd.

Section 2: "No-bid period" is defined as a time in which no bids should be distributed in any capacity.

Section 3: The Inter-Fraternity Council Vice President of Recruitment will oversee this policy

A. The Inter-Fraternity Council Vice President of Recruitment must make sure that bids are readily available as soon as the recruitment period begins.

Section 4: If passed, the dates reflected on this bill will be scheduled immediately.

Section 5: All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
