Old Business:

Article I, Section 8, Subsection B

Passed

i. Any fraternity that raises their overall New Member GPA (as determined by the Office of Student Engagement) from the previous, corresponding class from the year before (fall and fall, or spring and spring) can be awarded monies to their New Member Class for that semester in review.

ii. The financial incentive that can be awarded to the chapter must be used by the class in the form of a class gift or a financial contribution to Homecoming or Greek Week competitions.

- iii. The financial incentive will be awarded the semester after grades are available to the chapter and must be used the semester that it is awarded; otherwise, the gift will be forfeited.
- iv. The financial gift chosen by the class must be approved by the OSE and IFC Executive Board.
- v. The scale for determining the amount of money given to each fraternity from the IFC is as follows: 0.25-0.49 = \$25.00; 0.5-0.74 = \$50.00; 0.75-0.99 = \$125.00; any increase equal to or over 1.0 = \$250.00.
- vi. GPA increases will never be rounded up. For example, an increase of 0.999 will be calculated as an increase of 0.99, not 1
