- I. Bids
- i. Only IFC sanctioned bid cards are recognized by the university as a formal declaration to join a chapter on the Missouri State campus.
- ii. Bid cards will be distributed by the VP of Recruitment the night before the No Bid Period has ended.
- iii. All prospective members must register with the IFC before they will be allowed to sign a bid with a chapter at Missouri State University

Change to:

iii. Prospective members may only sign a chapter bid card, when concurrently signing an IFC sanctioned bid card.

- iv. A chapter may hand out bids any time during the year, except as during IFC Sponsored Recruitment and No bid Period.
- v. The No Bid Period shall take place from the Thursday before the first official day of classes, through the conclusion of the IFC Sponsored Recruitment.

Change to:

v. The No Bid Period shall begin the Thursday before the first official day of classes, and conclude on a day decided on by the IFC.

- a. This time period is designed to circulate new members between chapters and ensure that every chapter is adequately exposed to prospective members.
- b. There shall be no tangible formal or informal bid handed out during the no bid period, this includes any paperwork, items, electronic invites, or anything else that could be construed as an invitation to join a chapter. A verbal interest may be stated to a potential new member, but is in no way considered an official means of invitation to join a chapter.
