In order to ensure a smooth transition to Missouri State, students must include courses listed below while completing your Associate of Arts in Teaching degree. **Failure to complete the AAT in it's entirety will result in additional coursework and will likely delay graduation.** In addition to admission into Missouri State, you'll also need to be admitted into the Teacher Education Program. Admission to Teacher Education occurs upon completion of the following:

• Community College equivalent to COM 115 and ELE302 with a grade of C or better.	
• 2.50 Combined Cumulative GPA	
• Family Care Safety Registry	• ACT score (if required by DESE)
• Score of 265 or higher on all areas of the C-Base Exam (note: Higher than 235 required by the State of Missouri)	

This program has selective admission criteria. Admission is not guaranteed. While a 2.5 GPA is required for admission into any Transfer students should see an advisor at Missouri State prior to admission for assistance with this process.
