The following is a guide to graduation with a bachelor’s degree in **Elementary Education** by completing two years at OTC and two years at MSU. **Check class schedules for day/evening or online availability.**

Year 1 and Year 2 at OTC

Complete OTC’s **Associate of Arts of Teaching degree**. With an AAT Degree you will have met MSU’s general education requirements. Important notes about this MSU major

- The major requires either a minor or 12 hour emphasis in an approved area.

- Admit to the Teacher Education program requires: EDC150, ELE302 & COM115 (C grade or better), 2.5 GPA, CBASE passed with 265 (5 sections), Family Care Safety Registry, ACT (if required by DESE).
