The following is a guide to graduation with a bachelor’s degree in **Middle School Education** by completing two years at OTC and two years at MSU. **Check class schedules for day/evening or online availability.**

Year 1 and Year 2 at OTC

- Admit to the Teacher Education program requires: EDC150, SEC302 & COM115 (C grade or better), 2.5 GPA, CBASE passed with 265 (5 sections), Family Care Safety Registry, ACT (if required by DESE) and check point #1.
