MULTICULTURAL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

The Multicultural Leadership Scholarship covers in-state required student fees (up to 18 hours per semester) for the academic year (fall and spring semesters). To be considered, high school seniors must rank in the upper one-half of their class and be admitted to the university. Transfer students must also be admitted and have a minimum 2.75 cumulative grade point average and have completed at least 24 transferable credits. Currently enrolled students are not eligible to apply. All applicants must have demonstrated leadership in multicultural, school, and community activities. Historically underrepresented minorities at Missouri State University — African Americans, Asian Americans, Hispanics, and Native Americans — are encouraged to apply.

CRITERIA

Scholarship recipients are selected primarily on the basis of leadership through participation in school and community activities such as:

Band/Orchestra	Multicultural Organizations
Choir/Vocal Ensembles	Newspaper/Yearbook
Community Service	Student Government
Drama/Debate	Varsity Athletics

RENEWABILITY

The scholarship is renewable for up to four additional years beyond the freshman year. Recipients are required to successfully complete 24 credit hours each year at Missouri State University and maintain a 2.75 cumulative grade point average. Students must also participate in two multicultural activities per year and meet with their Multicultural Leadership Scholarship Advisor at least once each semester.

APPLICATION

Scholarship applicants must:

1. Apply for admission to the University. An application for admission should be submitted to the Admissions Office by February 1. Please include an official high school or college transcript, a copy of ACT or SAT scores, verification of current class rank, and the \$35 application fee.
2. Complete the Multicultural Leadership Scholarship application (also available online at www.missouristate.edu/multiculturalapp).
3. Attach a typewritten, double-spaced essay (not to exceed two pages) which describes your multicultural involvement, leadership experience, academic goals and career plans.
