**Health Record:** Please complete the enclosed Medical History and Release Forms, and bring them with you to camp registration.

**Important:** In case of injury or illness which would require a trip to the Campus Health Center or an Emergency Room, parents will be notified immediately. A bill will be sent to the parents. Please provide your child with the necessary information.

**Housing:** Campers are responsible for all damages to the residence hall as determined by the Camp Director and Head Resident. **There is a \$50 fee for lost keys!** Campers need to bring their own sheets, pillows, towels, and blanket. By having students furnish their own linens, the cost of housing is significantly reduced. "Auxiliary" Campers will be housed in **Blair-Shannon House** (417-836-5196).

**Counselors:** In addition to instructors, there will be a counselor for approximately every 15 students. Counselors live in the residence hall and will be coordinating and supervising daily and evening activities.

**Meals:** Meals will be served in the Blair-Shannon Dining Center.

**Vehicles:** Campers shall not leave the MSU campus without permission of the Camp Director. Campers are not to drive or ride in vehicles without parental consent and permission of the Camp Director. If a camper brings a vehicle to camp, keys should be stowed securely away in their personal belongings, and not used until departure on Friday. **If your vehicle will be parked on campus all week, be sure to ask which parking lot is designated as "camper parking" upon your arrival on campus. You will be ticketed if you are not in a designated lot.** All Commuters are expected to comply with rules while on the MSU Campus. Those who do not comply with this rule will be dismissed from the camp.
