NOTES: A minimum of 12 credit hours not counted as requirements on any other major or minor, and exclusive of "problems" and "readings" courses is required for the completion of any additional major in business.

To minimize the number of hours required for graduation, the student should carefully plan coursework outside COBA to meet general education, COBA, and accounting requirements.

All Accounting majors are recommended to complete at least 50% of required coursework outside COBA (63 hrs) and are required to complete at least 90 semester hours of required coursework outside ACC courses.
