Registration includes the training, all educational materials, and breakfast and lunch each day. Participants in this training will learn the Family Reconciliation Mediation model, a unique process that utilizes mediation to reconcile prolonged family disputes. The emphasis of this training is on family crisis decision-making, and includes a focus on couples, parents and children, adult siblings, and inter and intra-generational family conflicts. The model is also effective in addressing personnel grievance cases involving long-standing relationships in the workplace.
