Dr. Olesen, Ph.D. has worked in private practice for more than 20 years, with an emphasis on child abuse and neglect, custody and access disputes and the interface between clinical and forensic psychology. She has been involved in research regarding psychological testing in custody evaluations and regarding families undergoing custody evaluation. She has co-written articles and taught professional workshops about the analysis of child alienation and family abuse.

This workshop will address ways to differentiate alienation of children from abuse and domestic violence, and how to recognize the cases that are mixed in the causal factors. It will also address interventions that are being developed to treat families in which alienation is the cause of the child's resistance to contact with one of his or her parents.
