At the Libraries, we don't have a comparable type of workload policy because our faculty positions are intrinsically different (and therefore have a different matrix, approved by the Provost and President, reflecting that the focus is on librarianship) Each library faculty member has an operational job (e.g. reference service, cataloging, collection development/acquisitions). The Library Science program results in our faculty generally teaching one course approximately every other semester. Most of our research is "applied" and results from trying new technology or service applications in our library operations and sharing the results in presentation and publication. Other research work tends to progress somewhat more slowly than elsewhere on campus, due to the time commitments for the priority of librarianship responsibilities.
