

Racquetball

All players must sign the activity consent form and present their valid ZipCard prior to their first match. No one will be permitted to play without their ZipCard. No Exceptions!

This will be a continual random, single or double elimination tournament, depending on the number of entries. Opponents will be chosen prior to the start of competition. More specific information will be provided after the registration deadline has passed.

1. All matches will be self-officiated and the participants will settle any disputes. The Campus Recreation department will accept no rule protests.
2. Skill levels may be combined based on the number of entries received.
3. The use of eye-guards is strongly recommended, as there is a potential for eye injuries. They are available for checkout at Plaster Sports Complex with a valid Missouri State Zip-Card ID.
4. All participants must attend the scratch meeting scheduled before each night of competition.
5. Participants must provide their own playing equipment. All racquets must have a protective edge to prevent damage to the walls. Racquets can be checked out from Plaster Sports Complex Equipment Issue with a valid Missouri State Zip-Card ID.
6. **Each individual / team must bring an unopened can of racquetballs (Penn, Ektelon or Wilson).**
 - 6.1. For first round matches, only one can is allowed to be opened for the match with the loser taking the used can and the winner taking the unopened can to the next match.
 - 6.2. Thereafter, winners will continue through the tournament with the new unopened can and the tournament winner will end up with a new can of balls. Failure to bring a can of balls for any match may result in a forfeit.
7. The winner of a match will be determined as follows:
 - 7.1. A match will be best of 3 games. The first 2 games will be played to 15 points and the third game to 11. You only need to win by one point in any game (e.g., 15-14, 11-10)
8. Please limit warm-ups to 5 minutes at the beginning of a match.
9. In case of injury, the injured player has 5 minutes to decide whether he/she can continue. If not, the match is defaulted and the winner is advanced to the next round.
10. First place winner in each division will receive an Intramural Championship t-shirt. Shirts may be picked up from Campus Recreation, PSU 131, after 12 noon, the day following the competition.
11. Doubles Teams: Competitors must remain the same in both Prelims and Finals!
