The Kansas Crisis Hotline is a toll-free, 24-hour statewide crisis hotline developed to link victims of domestic violence and sexual assault to crisis programs across Kansas. The Hotline offers:

- Confidential, non-judgmental support.
- Crisis intervention to help you identify problems and possible solutions, including safety plans for emergencies.
- Referral to community programs or women's shelters for long term support.
- Information about domestic violence, sexual assault, child abuse, and intervention programs.

## **National Domestic Violence Hotline:**

If you need a **referral to a domestic violence shelter or program** in your area, call the National Domestic Violence Hotline at 800/799-SAFE (7233) or 800/787-3224 (TTY).

With a database of more than 4,000 shelters and service providers across the United States, Puerto Rico, Alaska, Hawaii and the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Hotline provides callers with information they might otherwise have found difficult or impossible to obtain. In fact, for approximately 60 percent of the callers, calling the Hotline is their first step in finding safety from the violence plaguing their lives.
