PHL 110	REL 100
<p>In order to meet the requirements for a Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree with a religious major, students will also need a philosophy course (OTC's PHL 101 or 105. While OTC's PHL 110 may count toward a general education requirement, it will <i>not</i> satisfy the need for a philosophy course for BA candidates.), six hours of fine arts courses (pick two from OTC's ART 101 or 105; ENG 200, 220, 225, 240 or 245; MUS 101; THR 101) and 12 hours of a single language. (12 hours of Spanish or 6 hours of German may be completed at OTC. MSU offers a larger variety of languages, some of which may be helpful in the study of specific areas of religious studies. Speak with a Religious Studies Advisor at MSU for further information.)</p>
