***For Ozarks Technical Community College Students
Interested in EARTH SCIENCE EDUCATION (Grades 9-12)***

If possible, include courses listed below while completing your Associate of Arts degree or 42-hour block at OTC. In addition to admission into Missouri State, students need to be admitted into the **Earth Science Education** Program which occurs upon completion of the following:

- COM 115, EDC 150 and SEC 302 with a grade of C or better and a 2.5 cumulative GPA (Missouri State and Transfer) with at least 30 credit hours
- Highway Patrol Background Check
- Portfolio Checkpoint #1 at Missouri State
- ACT score (if required by DESE)
- Score of 265 or higher on all areas of the C-BASE exam

*It is recommended that students take the C-BASE exam while enrolled in this course. If all components are not passed with a score of 265 or higher, students will need to retake failed components in order to continue beyond Missouri State's ELE 302. All components of the C-BASE must be passed within a two-year time limit if any score is below a 235.

Potential transfer students should apply for admission early in the semester prior to transfer in order to allow for early registration and possible scholarship options.
