***For Three Rivers Community College Students  
Interested in Missouri State University's Business Majors***

If possible, include courses listed below while completing your Associate of Arts degree or 42-hour block at Three Rivers. In addition to admission into Missouri State University, you will need to be admitted into the business major of your choice. All business majors, except Industrial Management Majors, must complete the courses below and have a minimum GPA of 2.5 for admission. Students with less than a 2.5 combined GPA may apply for admission as an exception, with admission decisions made by the 8th week of the Fall and Spring semesters and by the 6th week of the Summer semester. If you do not complete all of these courses while enrolled at your community college, you can expect to take them at Missouri State within your first few semesters.
