Registration Day and Transfer Student Advisement Thoughts

1. Transfer Student Advisement and Registration Day that occurred on June 22 came with mixed reviews from the committee and from the Transfer Advising Council.
2. The thoughts from the council were that the resource tables were not needed, but there was high praise about the high turnout for getting transfer students registered before August.
3. Members from the committee thought there were pros and cons to the event:
 - a. Pros:
 - i. Having the students know sooner rather than later about the need to register as soon as possible.
 - ii. Students understanding the need to research the majors
 - b. Cons:
 - i. Registration process, too many people communicating or attempting to communicate with students on appointment times
 - ii. Relaying back to the student about why the event is important or valuable to them. Students did not always understand the need of this day
 - iii. Communication between departments such as advising and admissions as to what is being said to students
4. Assessment of the event will go out through a survey for students that attended.
 - a. The survey is something the committee would like to know more about such as: what were the questions that were on the survey and what were the results.
5. Committee also thought that advisors working the even should also have a survey as well. The thought that it may be too late by now was also brought up.

6. Members thought it would be a good idea for each department to take over their own students for communication instead of having two people over the appointment set up not even a part of that said college.
