<sup>1</sup>Choose from at least 5 areas, 24 hours from: Accounting, Business Relationships, Computer Information Systems, **Finance, International, Management, Marketing, Real Estate, and Risk Management & Insurance.** See current catalog for specific courses.

<sup>2</sup>At least 125 total hours is required for graduation. BUS 110 is counted as an elective due to prerequisites – it counts towards 125 total hours. Other elective hours taken at MSU can also be taken at OTC instead. Fifty percent of all business coursework must be completed at MSU. At least 40 hours of 300-level or above coursework is required for graduation.

<sup>3</sup>Globalization requirements include six hours of foreign language or culture. Six hours of foreign language is included in the AA degree. FIN 582 or LAW 539 can also count towards the globalization area. At least three hours must be non-business.

Must get a C or higher in College Algebra (MTH 130) if ACC 201 (ACC 220) & QBA 237 (MTH 210) are taken at MSU.
