Of the **2,608 first-time freshmen** who graduated from high school in 2006 and enrolled at Missouri State University in fall 2006, **1,450 (55.6 percent) had college credit**, through other institutions, Missouri State, Advanced placement, and/or CLEP.

- The average number of credit hours earned by the 1,450 students was 12.3
- A total of 203 (7.8 percent) students earned Advanced Placement credit
- A total of 320 (12.3 percent) students had Missouri State University credit
- A total of 1,170 (44.9 percent) students earned credit from other institutions
