ANALYSIS OF FALL 2002 OTC-SMSU ENROLLMENT

The names and social security numbers of 8,132 students who are enrolled for the fall 2002 semester at OTC were matched against the SMSU student data system. The following data were generated.

- 1. Of the 8,132 students 6,336 (77.9 percent) had not attended SMSU (unless prior to 1984).
- 2. 315 (3.8 percent) of the 8,132 students were cross-enrolled for the fall 2002 semester.

3. 259 students applied for admission or readmission to SMSU for the fall 2002 semester but chose to enroll at OTC instead. Of these, 48 were previous SMSU students and 211 had never attended SMSU before. Of the 211 new applicants to SMSU, 29 were admitted, 87 were denied, and 95 had incomplete credentials (e.g., we had not received required transcripts).

4. 1,222 OTC students (15 percent of their total) had attended SMSU previously but were not currently cross-enrolled or had not applied for readmission to SMSU for the fall 2002 semester.

Of the 1,222 students:

- 351 were suspended from SMSU following their last semester.
- 196 were on probation when they last attended SMSU.
- 675 were in good academic standing at SMSU.
- 252 last attended SMSU in spring 2001.
- 19 last attended SMSU in summer 2001.
- 117 last attended SMSU in fall 2000.
- 834 last attended SMSU prior to fall 2000.
