## Instructional Technology Advisory Committee (ITAC) Major Initiative and Action Items for 2016-17

One of the goals contained in the university's Strategic Information Technology Plan for 2016-17 is:

Optimize the use of technology in teaching and learning in collaboration with academic leadership, including understanding the appropriate level of technology to utilize.

In support of this goal, IT Council has assigned the Instructional Technology Advisory Committee (ITAC) a major initiative to expand and enhance the capabilities of the university's technology-enhanced classrooms and related support services.

This major initiative contains the following action items

- 1) Conduct a review of all technology-enhanced classrooms and associated technology levels to determine if current standards need modified.
- 2) Based on the success of the Classroom High-Density Wireless Pilot Project, begin upgrading wireless access to support increased density needs in technology-enhanced classrooms.
- 3) Ensure the university's resource scheduling system contains accurate information concerning instructional technology assets.
- 4) Identify lifecycle-funding issues and develop a plan to address predicted shortcomings.
