- Fully fund the SCUF Reserve



## FY 2018 Estimated Funding

Estimated revenue

- **=** \$2,233,000
- an increase of \$56,000 over FY 2017
- Additional funding
  - FY 2016 Additional Revenue = \$ 46,358
  - FY 2016 Unused Reserve = \$ 114,334
- Total funding

= \$2,393,692



## FY 2018 Estimated Funding

- Bear Print revenue
  - \$48,565 in net assets from BearPrint cards
  - These funds will be used for future printer replacements



## Funding the Reserve for FY 2018

- Goal to fund at 10% of revenue =\$223,300
- Reserve funded at \$218,972
- Sources
  - FY 2016 additional revenue; \$ 46,358
  - FY 2016 unused reserve; \$114,334
  - Ongoing funding; \$ 58,280



#### **Proposals for FY 2018**

- 46 Proposals were received.
  - Seven (7) more than FY 2017
- Proposals totaled: \$2,512,370
  - \$194,879 more than FY 2017



## The Proposal-Funding Gap

- FY 2018 Proposals exceed estimated funding by: \$105,248
- FY 2017 Proposals exceed estimated funding by: \$115,876
- FY 2016 Proposals less than estimated funding by: (\$22,102)
- FY 2015 Proposals exceed estimated funding by: \$45,750
- FY 2014 Proposals exceed estimated funding by: \$232,512

Funded Proposals: \$2,174,720

SCUF RESERVE (partial): \$218,972

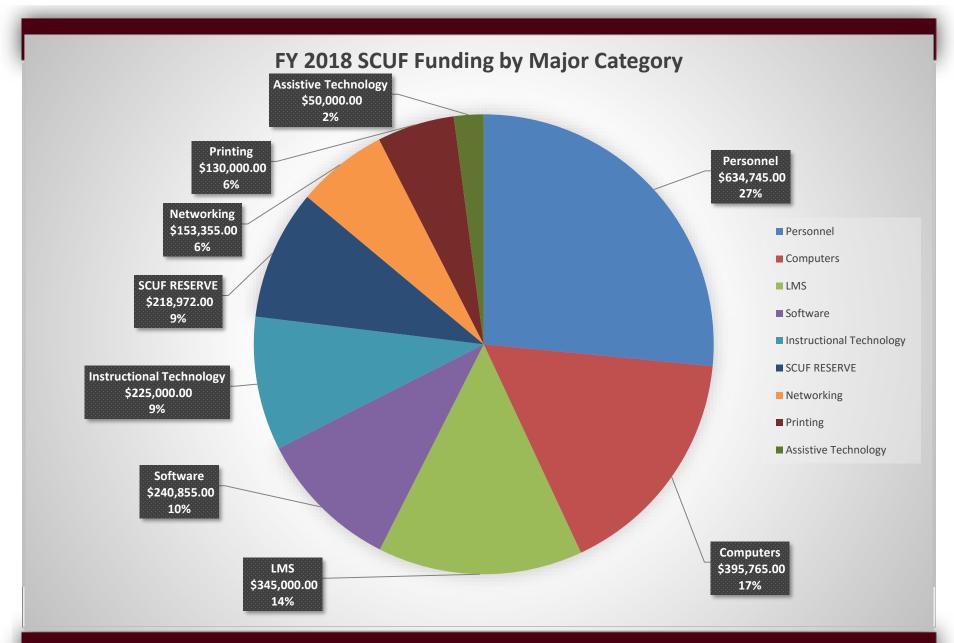

•	SCUF CENTRAL CLASSROOM TECH:	\$225,000
•	SCUF CENTRAL SOFTWARE:	\$213,725
•	SCUF CENTRAL PRINTING:	\$130,000
•	SCUF CENTRAL ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY	\$50,000
•	SCUF CENTRAL STUDENT WIRELESS ACCESS:	\$50,000

Total of SCUF CENTRAL Funds: \$1,333,975





#### **Observations**

- Increased enrollment (revenue) has helped offset increased costs
- Utilization of prior year savings in the current budget year has eased the burden, this year
- This is "kicking the can down the road" Increasing costs are still a concern
