## SCUF Funding Projection for FY 2013

- Estimated Revenue: \$ 2,103,000.00
  - Decrease of \$14,000.00 from FY 2012
- One-time Adobe funding: \$ 126,000.00
- Total funding: \$ 2,229,000.00
  - SCUF Reserve: \$ 210,300.00



# Proposals for FY 2012 SCUF Funding

- 69 Proposals were received.
  - The same as for FY 2012.\*

- Proposals totaled: \$2,430,765.00
  - \$99,544.00 less than last year.



#### The Proposal-Funding Gap

- FY 2013 Proposals exceed available funding by \$201,765.00
- FY 2012 Proposals exceed available funding by \$413,309.00
- FY 2011 Proposals exceeded available funding by \$1,218,584.00
- FY 2010 Proposals exceeded available funding by \$612,602.56

- Ongoing Commitments/Lifecycle.



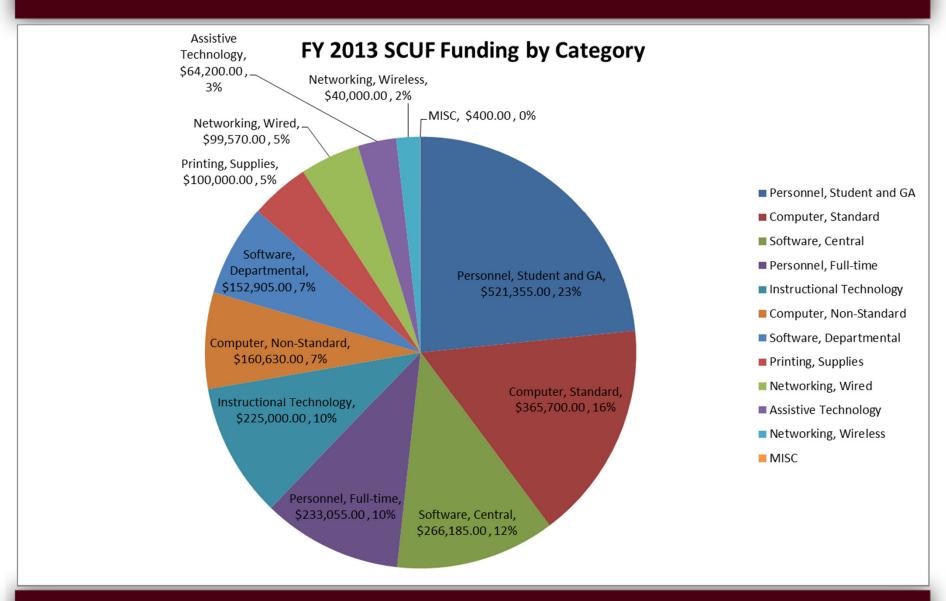
#### **Student Worker Pay Rates**

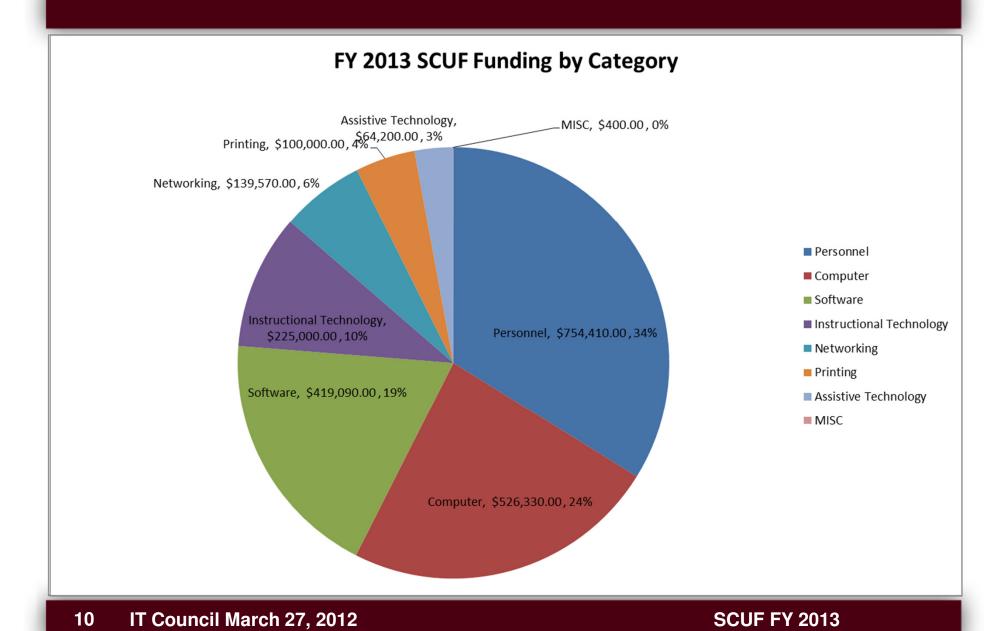
- Proposed Pay Rates for FY 2013
