Proposals for FY 2015 SCUF Funding

46 Proposals were received.

Fourteen fewer than were received for FY 2014.

• **Proposals totaled:** \$2,165,750.00

\$169,762.39 less than last year.



FY 2015 Estimated Revenue

- Estimated revenue = \$2,120,000.00
- This is an increase of \$17,000.00 over FY 2014



The Proposal-Funding Gap

- FY 2015 Proposals exceed estimated funding by: \$45,750.00
- FY 2014 Proposals exceed estimated funding by: \$232,512.39
- FY 2013 Proposals exceed available funding by: \$201,765.00
- FY 2012 Proposals exceed available funding by: \$413,309.00
- FY 2011 Proposals exceeded available funding by: \$1,218,584.00

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Computer Literacy Program

- The Computer Literacy program is no longer a General Education requirement and will no longer be funded through SCUF.
- The SCUF funding traditionally allocated for Computer Literacy is going to be allocated to the Learning Management System (LMS).



SCUF CENTRAL LMS

- Learning Management System (LMS) expenses are now covered from the new SCUF CENTRAL LMS fund instead of SCUF CENTRAL SOFTWARE.
- This will provide sufficient funding for the ongoing maintenance and planned expansion of the University's Learning Management System (LMS) environment.
- FY 2015 Allocation: \$275,000.00



Adobe Licensing Changes

- Adobe is removing the licensing options that the SCUF proposals were based on.
- The new licensing options won't be official until the beginning of May 2014.
- Adobe requests are listed as "Pending" until we have more information.

 This funding could be used to cover Adobe licensing costs once we know more information in May 2014.



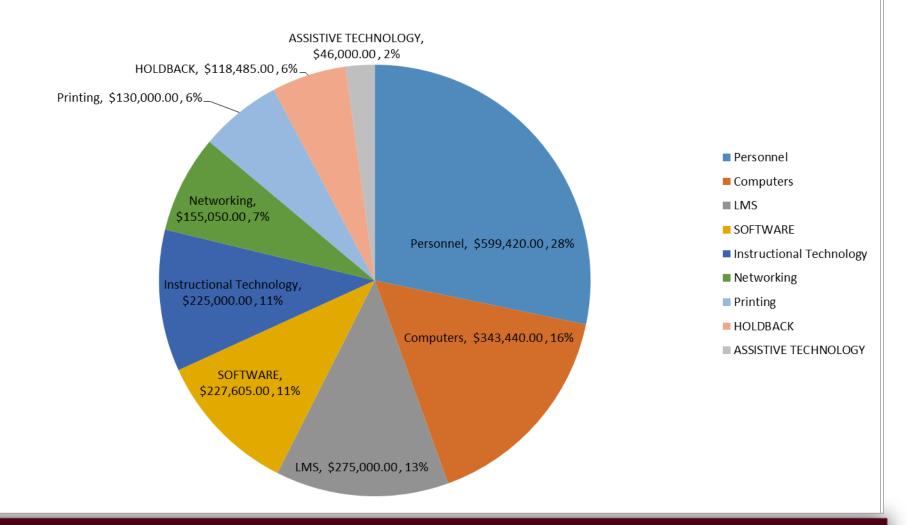

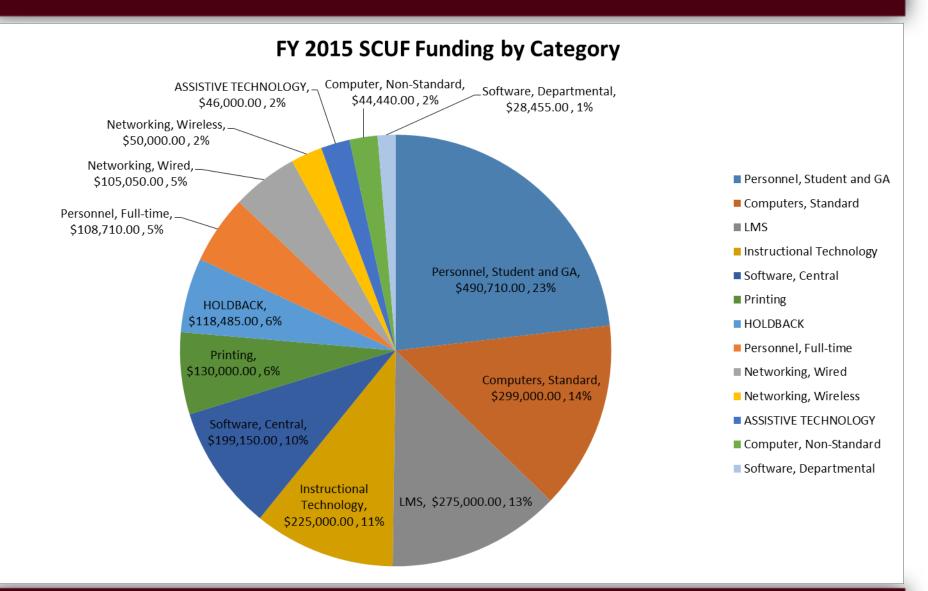
