The University continues to prepare for Windows 10 end-of-life, scheduled for October 2025.

For PCs across the University, as of 02/01/2024:

3,826 are on Windows 11 2,357 are on Windows 10

Of the computers not yet on Windows 11:

1,226 Cannot Upgrade to Windows 11

- Replacement plans are being managed department by department, to ensure replacements meet current departmental needs.
- Not all non-compatible devices will be replaced. Departments are evaluating their PC usage, and some are reducing their inventory as part of this process.
- Replacement cost is approximately \$1,200-1,500 per device.

1,131 are Compatible but Awaiting Upgrade to Windows 11

Central and Distributed IT support staff are updating compatible devices on a schedule that works for each area.

- 131 Azure AD devices awaiting Windows 11 will be automatically updated very soon. These devices have been added to a group which allows them to get the Windows 11 update. Since we do not have control over the timing for Azure AD devices, the update could happen any time over the next several days or weeks.
- 283 Local AD devices are awaiting Windows 11 upgrade. In order to be as non-disruptive as possible,
 Win11 download will be made available in Software Center for these devices. User Support will be
 communicating directly to these users with instructions to perform the update from Software
 Center at a time that is convenient for them between now and June 1. Any remaining centrally
 supported devices not updated by June 1 will then be automatically updated by User Support.
