5. Blackboard Cloud discussion:

Message sent to faculty from the LMS Advisory Committee regarding changes with the Blackboard system was unclear. Discussed points which were inaccurate or unclear. Committee members agreed that better phrasing and sending messages several times ahead of future events with accurate information and follow-up messages from MS Online would provide clarity and more time for preparation.

Committee members discussed the hosting platform changes with Blackboard. Function and appearance remain in familiar format, service greatly expands capacity for online courses. Three years of online courses are archived, faculty can save their own courses as well. Transition to cloud service over summer. MSU has a one-year contract with Software as a Service, with option for 4 renewals.
