2015 Master Online Course Recognition Award Recipients Announced



Professor Eric Nelson was selected as the recipient of this year's Master Online Course Recognition Award. Missouri State Online selects the annual winner based upon a best practices rubric in the design and delivery of distance education course material. Dr. Nelson's course, HST 397 Europe: Paleolithic to 1650 was judged best in all categories from a highly competitive pool of nominees. This is Dr. Nelson's second Master Online Course Recognition Award. He was the recipient of the first award in 2010.

Professor Vicki Schmitt has also received recognition for her online course SFR 486 Management and Assessment in the Middle and Secondary Classroom. The Master Online Course Recognition Award selection panel recognized her course as best in the category of Course Design, Organization and Instructional Materials.

Both recipients will be honored for their achievement during the spring All-Faculty Recognition Reception.

Online Course Evaluations Completion Rate Update

Utilization of a new pop-box reminder in Blackboard has led to dramatic increases in the student response rate in our online course evaluations. Rates have jumped from the upper thirty and lower forty percentile range, to 74.73% for the full 2015 fall semester. Fall 2015 first and second block courses rose from the lower thirty percentiles to 66.2% and 66.87% respectively. The first block spring 2016 courses have were completed at a rate of 70.91%.

Update on SARA

At the start of 2016 36 states have become members of SARA (State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements). 613 participating institutions of higher education now allow students in each state to attend online courses while residing in other member states. Growth is continuing with new states currently passing legislation to join in SARA in 2016. Missouri State University has been a member since May 2015.

Online Test Proctoring Center

Beginning this spring semester 2016, the Missouri State Test Proctoring Center has provided additional evening hours for proctoring in collaboration with the Testing Center in the Meyer Library, Lower Level, room 010.
