This letter is to advise you of the action of the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND®) board regarding the Didactic Program in Dietetics at Missouri State University. During its June 24-26, 2015 meeting, the ACEND board voted to continue full accreditation of your program for a term of seven years ending on December 31, 2022. Accreditation is granted for a Didactic Program in Dietetics at the baccalaureate level for a maximum enrollment of 35 third- and 35 fourth-year students.

The decision was based on a peer review of your self-study report addressing the 2012 Accreditation Standards, site visit report and your program's response. ACEND recognizes your program's compliance with the 2012 Accreditation Standards and encourages you to continue your efforts in providing quality dietetics education.

The next accreditation review of your program by the ACEND board will be in 2022. You will receive correspondence at least one year in advance of the site visit, which will be scheduled between August and December 2021, inviting you to apply for full accreditation under the Accreditation Standards in effect at that time.

If major changes occur in your program, you must submit them in writing to ACEND for review prior to implementation. The ACEND board maintains the right to require an interim report, self-study report, and/or site visit as a result of any changes.
