Internship Information Application

Internship at Center City Counseling Clinic is open to students in the Missouri State University's Counseling Program who have successfully completed Practicum and have submitted all documents needed to enroll in Internship (see the Program Internship Guidelines)

Interns serving at Center City Counseling Clinic are expected to have a strong skill set to work with a variety of clients and must demonstrate a high degree of cultural consciousness. This would be evidenced by an appreciation for diverse populations, including the impact of various identity characteristics on human concerns: age, gender, socioeconomic class, ethnic, national, racial, sexual orientation, religious/spiritual, intellectual and other variances.

Activities during Internship at CCCC:

- Interns at the Clinic will engage in counseling work with individual adults with a variety of presenting concerns.
- Other counseling work may be assigned if it is within the student's scope of practice and with the approval of the student's licensed supervisor.
- **Note:** The clinic has an obligation to provide clients *first* to practicum students before scheduling with interns. Clients who present needing times that are not available during practicum classes, or whose issues are at a higher level than is appropriate to practicum, will be assigned to interns even if there are openings available. Additionally, couples can be assigned to interns if there are not practicum students meeting the requirements to see couples.
- The student is expected to
 - Attend the University's Internship class for group supervision at all times while serving as an intern at Center City Counseling Clinic.
 - Have one hour individual supervision each week with the Clinic Director/Supervisor to review case notes, discuss issues and/or problems related to client sessions and process self-issues related to client care.
 - Provide verification of Professional Liability Insurance
 - Work with the Clinic Director/Supervisor in scheduling clients as well as client fee documentation.
