Description of the activities that occur at your site:

We have two locations in Springfield: Institute of Learning and Center for Autism:

<u>Institute of Learning:</u> A school with individualized academic programming for students with Autism Spectrum Exceptionalities, Learning and Emotional Disabilities between the grades of K-12. The school uses integrate technology and a rotational system of instruction.

<u>Center for Autism:</u> A school with individualized language based programming for students with Autism Spectrum Exceptionalities between the ages of 2-12. The students in this program are instructed through discrete trial training, a social skills lab, independent play, activity schedules, a motor lab, natural environment teaching, group instruction, and self-help and life skills.

Both schools have an emphasis on social and behavioral needs.

Description of practicum students' duties at your site:

Most of our practicum students work one on one or in small groups while being supervised by the teacher. If one is interested in the area of autism, we will provide training to do discrete trials using applied behavior principles

Our autism program serves children ages 2-12 and our Institute of Learning classrooms are for children 5-18 years.
