GUEST SPEAKER

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

EXECUTIVE REPORTS

- Chair Report
 - Chair Jones reported that we would be calling for nominations for senators on March 16th. - Senator Chavez nominated Senator Moore for Coordinator of Committees and Senator Moore accepted.
- Chair Jones nominated Senator Reed for Chair Elect and Senator Reed said he would think about it.
- Officer nominations will be accepted through our April Senate meeting.

EXTERNAL REPRESENTATION REPORTS

- Council for Staff Excellence Service Awards-Senator Hader reported that they are testing the new nomination system.
- Student Government-Senator Hains reported that they are taking a couple of weeks off with spring break coming up, but they are wanting to add a new student fees for travel.
- Sustainability Commission-Senator Klem reported that the campus garden will be fully funded.
