Guest speaker President Smart

President Smart spoke to the Senate on the following topics:

- The recent 2% salary increase and merit pay increases which affected 15% of employees through the advocacy of Staff Senate leadership.
- Expansion of the shared leave pool.
- The change in the Fair Labor Standards Act affecting professional employees in executive/administrative positions. The new threshold has moved from 23,000 to 47,500 and will begin December 1, 2016. The university is planning and working with strategies in handling the changes in wages and classifications. The goal is to have consistency across divisions.

President Smart answered several questions from the Senate.
