Event Description:

The donation challenge is an event that will take place during Greek Week. It is a supply drive for the Bear Pantry. The Bear Pantry is our campus supply bank for students at Missouri State who find themselves in need. The Bear Pantry’s mission is to serve students at Missouri State and make food and hygiene products available to all students. The day of the drive, there will be nine bins, each with team numbers, outside of the Center for Community Engagement (CCE) on the first floor of the PSU. We will be collecting the specific items each day as follows:

<u>Day 1 Items – April 8th</u> 1 POINT FOR EVERY INDIVIDUAL ITEM	<u>Day 2 Items – April 9th</u> 1 POINT FOR EVERY POUND	<u>Day 3 Items – April 10th</u> (can be gently used items) 1 POINT FOR EVERY ITEM

Conditioner	Peanut Butter	Children’s shoes (1 pair = 1 item)
Body Wash	Cereal	Children’s toys (small and medium sizes and NO stuffed animals)
Toothpaste	Canned Fruit	Children’s books
Deodorant	Canned Vegetables	Bedding
Tampons/Pads	Beans, Soups, or Stews	Children’s games
Toilet Paper	Boxed Rice
