   Submitting a formal application, with accompanying forms, to the School of Social Work office. Applications for admission to the Program will be available online.

   Verify the application due dates with the MSU Transfer Advisor as dates can vary.

   Admission is competitive and selective and not all who apply can be accommodated. Meeting the minimum standards does not guarantee a student will be admitted.
