Important notes about this MSU major:

* Globalization requirement – May be met by completing one of the following options: Completion of a full-semester of study away experience; Completion of six hours of the SAME foreign language as above noted; Completion of a study abroad internship; Completion of an international short-term MSU faculty-led program; Completion of six hours of foreign culture courses as above noted. The study away, study abroad internship and faculty-led program options require preapproval. *Courses are Admission Requirements to MSU's College of Business. - Students must get a "C" or higher, in College Algebra (Crowder's MATH 135), if ACC 201 & QBA 237 are taken at MSU.

- Admission to the College of Business in Solite (Browners), is Accessed and the solite of the College of Business in Solite (College of Business), is Accessed and the College of Business in Separate from admission to the University. Students must have completed at least 54 hours (MSU and/or transfer), have at least a 2.50 cumulative GPA (MSU and/or transfer GPA), and completion of at least 10 of the 12 admission courses Odenoted above. Up to two of the above Odenoted admission courses may be completed during the semester of admission; however, students should make every effort to complete all of the Odenoted courses prior to admission to the College of Business.

GPA requirements include a minimum 2.00 Missouri State GPA and a minimum 2.50 combined GPA
to apply for admission to the College of Business.

• Crowder students are strongly encouraged to meet with their major specific MSU transfer advisor early in their Crowder education to discuss the most appropriate Crowder coursework for their intended MSU major, MSU degree requirements, etc.
