This program gives students an alternative way to pay parking citations by completing community service hours. Students will have 15 days from the date the citation was issued to complete their community service hours as a part of the program.

- No ticket that is valued more than \$53.00
- No citation issued to to illegal parking in a handicap space can be worked off
- Only one ticket per student, per semester, can be worked off by this program
- The community service hours done are only allowed to be used for this program
- This program ends after \$6,000 worth of parking citations have been worked off
