Develops and provides online tools to assists U.S. citizens to register and vote and request their absentee ballot using their state's specific forms. Aims for every citizen to have open access to voter information and the ability to easily engage in their democracy and civic life with voting as a central action.

Local chapter of the national league, a nonpartisan political organization, encourages informed and active participation in government, works to increase understanding of major public policy issues, and influences public policy through education and advocacy.



Provides factual, unbiased information on candidates through voting records, biographical and contact information, issue positions, interest group ratings, public statements, and campaign finances.



Allows voters to explore ballots and make informed choices when voting at the polls. Available for desktop or mobile devices.

Gov Track: www.govtrack.us

Publishes the status of federal legislation, information about your representative and senators in Congress including voting records, and original research on legislation and congressional oversight an investigations.

A mobile app that allows you to connect with your respresentatives. Get alerts when they vote and tell them what you think.

## ISSUE VOTER Issue Voter: www.issuevoter.org

Web-based platform to keep you up-to-date with bills being voted on by Congress. Allows you to send your opinion directly to your representatives and track your rep's votes and bill outcomes.

## COUNTABLE Countable: www.countable.us

Mobile app simiar to Issue Voter providing a quick and easy way to understand the laws Congress are considering. Streamline the process of contacting your lawmaker to tell them how you want them to vote on bills under consideration. Follow-up how your elected officials volted to hold them accountable.
