# **ACADEMIC INTEGRITY PROCESS SUMMARY**

## 1. INSTRUCTOR/STUDENT DISCUSSION

- There must be communication between the instructor and the student, either face-to-face, or electronically.
- The instructor must present the student with the following information:
  - o The allegation of academic dishonesty and any evidence supporting that specific allegation
  - The intended sanction
- The student should present evidence of their innocence

### **2A. AI VIOLATION OCCURRED**

- If the instructor still believes that a violation has occurred, they need to complete the online Academic Integrity Incident Report.
- The AI Office will forward the violation and intended sanctions to the student, Department Head, and Director of International Services if applicable.

#### **2B. NO AI VIOLATION OCCURRED**

 If the instructor believes that a violation has not occurred, based upon the communication with the student, the allegations will be dropped.



# 3A. NO APPEAL TO THE DEPARTMENT HEAD

- If the student does not choose to appeal the violation, then the records are kept and the sanction(s) indicated by the instructor are enforced.
  - The sanction selected by the instructor cannot be changed by the Department Head or by the AIC, unless records show multiple violations for the student then a hearing may be held.

#### **3B. APPEAL TO THE DEPARTMENT HEAD**

- If the student wants to appeal to the Department Head, they must complete the online form within 5 academic days of notification via the Incident Report.
- The student schedules a meeting with the Department Head to discuss the situation. The Department Head will fill out the online decision form to either grant or deny the appeal.

# 4A. NO APPEAL TO THE ACADEMIC INTEGRITY COUNCIL

5. If the instructor and the student choose not to appeal to the AIC, the decision of the Department Head remains.



# 4B. APPEAL TO THE ACADEMIC INTEGRITY COUNCIL

- The instructor or student can appeal to the AIC for a hearing within 15 academic days of receiving the Department Head's decision.
- If either person chooses to appeal to the AIC they must complete the online form.

### **5A. NO REQUEST FOR A REVIEW**

1. If the student, instructor, or AIC Chair choose not to request a review, the AIC Panel decision remains.



### **5B. REVIEW BY THE ACADEMIC INTEGRITY COUNCIL**

- 2. The student, instructor, or AIC Chair have the right to request a review of the panel's decision within 15 academic days of receiving the results.
