Advisor Forum on September 17, 2018 Thoughts

1. Committee thought that the forum went well. Everyone was very happy to have people on the panel such as Don Simpson and Nathan Hoff
2. There were questions from the audience that seemed out of place or too little knowledge of what Core 42 was. Committee decided that if to do another forum over Core 42, moderate knowledge about the subject would be good if attending the forum. We thought this would be good to put in the synopsis.
3. Committee sees a need to have another advisor forum in the spring over Core 42 just to see how we are adjusting to the new general education requirements for Core 42 and to be able to let advisors know about possible additions to classes for the next academic year.

5. Several questions to put into the survey were suggested. A folder will be put into our 365 group to keep everyone's sample questions.
