Council Charge

Charge 1

The purpose of the Provost's Academic Advising Council (PAAC) is to evaluate the administration and delivery of advising services to all students at Missouri State University and to make recommendations for improvements.

Charge 2

The PAAC will identify current advising practices that are successful and encourage those practices among more advisors.

Charge 3

The PAAC will work to enhance consistency and quality within the advising system and support student development initiatives.

Charge 4

The PAAC is available for consultation as policy decisions are made that affect academic advising practice at Missouri State University.

PAAC Membership

Membership is made up of standing members and rotating members. Rotating members represent different colleges, advisor types, or related areas and serve two year terms. The chart below contains a membership list for 2017-2018 that contains the member's name, area of representation, and term expiration information. Nominations of new PAAC members are typically coordinated by Kathy Davis and the incoming PAAC chair. PAAC Primary Administrative Actions, Accomplishments, Efforts, and Guests

The following page contains highlights of the actions, accomplishments, and efforts of the PAAC for the 2017-2018 academic year. Administrative actions are defined as specific actions completed by the PAAC. Accomplishments are defined as initiatives introduced by the PAAC that led (or could lead) to the introduction of a related action by the University. Efforts are defined as items where the PAAC attempted to measure, initiate, or improve a process or ideas that may be yet incomplete or not able to be measured.

PAAC Administrative Actions

- Establishment of two new standing members of PAAC. One standing member is to represent the Education Advisement Center and is currently filled by the coordinator of the Professional Education advisement office. The other standing member is intended to add a first year/first generation perspective and is currently filled by the Assistant Director of First Year Programs.
- In coordination with the Curtis P. Lawrence Excellence in Advisement Awards, the PAAC selected School of Nursing staff (Cynthia Hagenhoff and Lori Vaughn) for the Excellence in Advisement Support Award. Chelsea Martin from Biology received the Excellence in Advisement Graduate Student award. Brittany Wise was selected as the winner of the Curtis P. Lawrence Excellence in Advising professional advisor category, and Danielle Lillge was recognized in the faculty advisor category.

PAAC Accomplishments

Developed a web form on the PAAC webpage (pictured below) which will allow faculty
and staff to submit topics for the council's consideration. This process will heighten
PAAC's presence across campus and serve as an opportunity to increase communication
between PAAC and advisors.

- Created advising guides in a shared <u>One Drive</u> folder which provides advisors with in depth information about various student resources. These guides will be used by advisors to assist them with making informed decisions regarding resource referrals.
- Official PAAC minutes will be posted on the PAAC website after each meeting beginning fall 2018.

PAAC Efforts

- A Finish in Four subcommittee was created to discuss this initiative at Missouri State
 University- the group will be examining trainings, materials, and implementation. The
 subcommittee is currently working with the PSU student design team to create a Finish
 in Four logo. This subcommittee has expressed interest in continuing this initiative for
 2018-2019.
- PAAC members and PAAC forum participants were interested in further discussion related to a booking/texting system for advisors. As a result of this interest, Don Simpson and Amie Squibb presented preliminary information on possible options. PAAC provided feedback as to the pros/cons of such delivery systems.
- Members of the 2016-2017 subcommittee that investigated group advising and created a Best Practices for Group Advising shared their findings from advising surveys as the information was not complete until summer 2017.
- PAAC members participated in an academic advisor forum entitled, ""Meet the Provost's Academic Advising Council" on February 27, 2018. This advisor forum served as continuous outreach to the advising community.
