Conclusions Reached

 Inconsistency in type and quality of projects produced (seminar paper/professional project).

 Lack of clarity among students AND faculty with regard to research option requirements/differences.

- 2. Better disseminate guidelines/instructions (put on website AND distribute to student/advisor when appropriate).
