Action Items: Offer Supervision of Student Teachers course for those interested. Offer Career Development as a topic for Advanced Technical Course in the summer. Applied for Hospitality Tourism Management training grant.

Follow-up Plans: Will review summer course offerings and continue to develop more graduate courses. Attended Hospitality Tourism Management Training and received Certified Hospitality Instructor Level 1 certification.

Issues above the Department Level: Continue support for MoPTA (now MEES) certification requirements from the EPPC and DESE. Seek financial support from Deans Office for additional grant opportunities through DESE.
