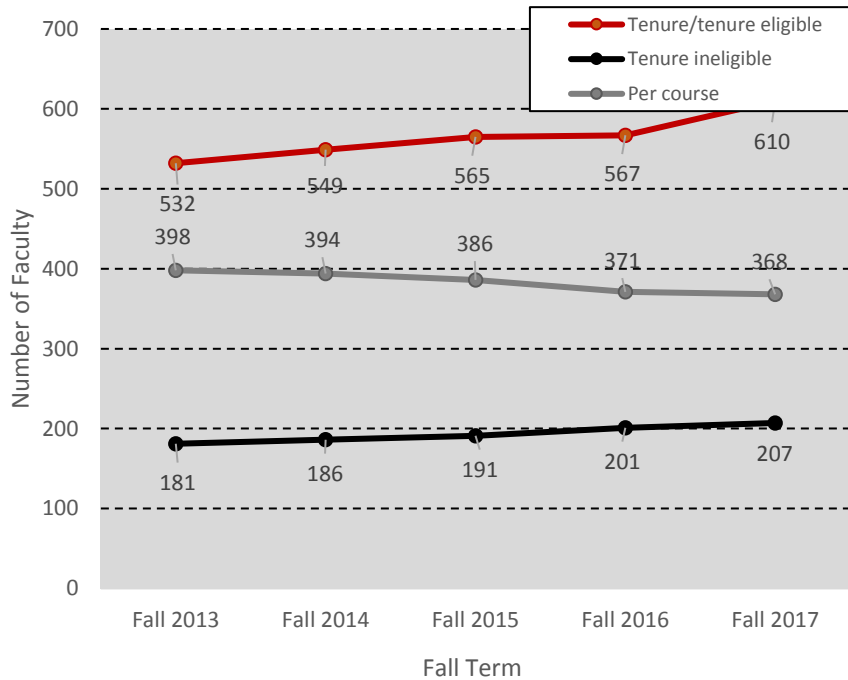

### Overview

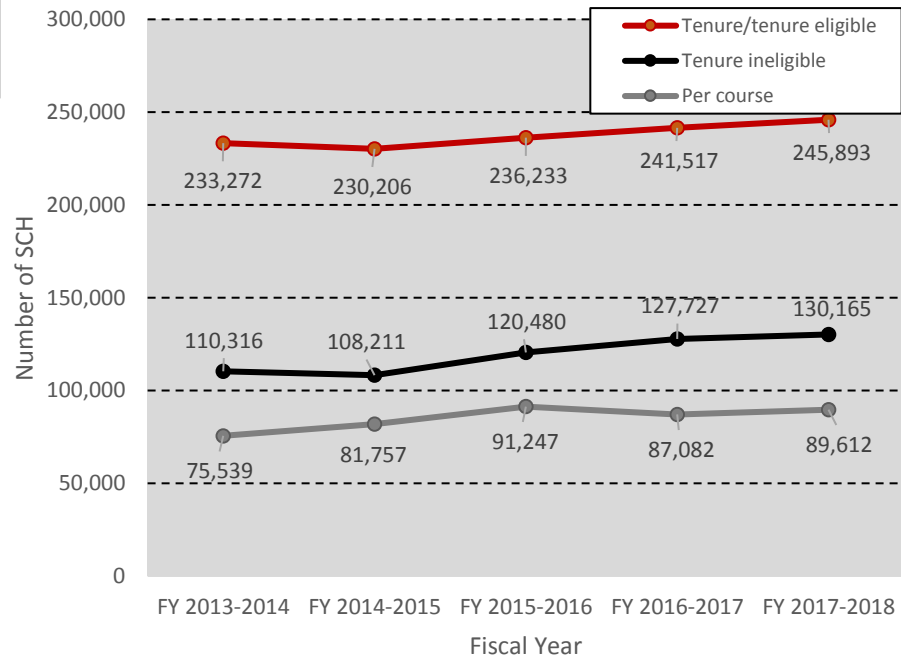
Selected Fall 2017 data used for this report are derived from the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Delaware Cost Study and may not align with data from other sources, such as IPEDS, due to possible differences in data definitions. MSU specific data in Tables 1 through 4 are based on standard data definitions and include faculty who were excluded from the Delaware study such as dual credit faculty.

Beginning fall 2015, to ensure compliance with state law and the Missouri Department of Higher Education guidelines for posting Consumer Information, regardless of rank and credential, all faculty are required to submit an official transcript documenting highest degree (section 173.1004; SB 389, 94th General Assembly, First Regular Session (2007)).

#### Productivity Comparison Data Introduction

Annually, the MSU Office of Institutional Research reports information regarding the number of faculty, student credit hour production, and faculty credentials for the National Study of Instructional Costs and Productivity, better known as the Delaware Cost Study. The Delaware Study is administered by the Higher Education Consortia at the University of Delaware and is generally acknowledged as the “tool of choice” for comparative analysis of faculty teaching loads, direct instructional cost, and separately budgeted scholarly activity at the level of academic discipline. Additionally, the Delaware study provides the capability to benchmark institutional data with academic units and institutions not just overall, but among comparators that make sense for MSU.

Since its inception in 1996, over 600 institutions have participated in the Delaware Cost Study. The Study continues to be used by major data consortia and state agencies such as the Association of American Universities Data Exchange (AAUDE), the Southern Universities Group (SUG), the University of North Carolina (UNC) System, and the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education (PASSHE), among others.

- (3) UG/GR (Undergraduate/Graduate Mix) data represent averages for Delaware institutions categorized with similar Undergraduate to Graduate ratios in the indicated discipline for the report year.
- (4) High Degree data represent averages for all Delaware institutions offering similar highest degree within the indicated discipline during the report year.

- (1) The Music Department average cost to produce 1 credit hour is reported on Table 8 as \$379.
- (2) In the Music Department Carnegie Classification columns below, the 25th percentile value = \$249, and the 50th percentile value = \$444.  
Since \$379 falls between \$249 and \$444, the quartile placement for MSU is the 26 to 50 quartile.
- (3) Furthermore, the Undergraduation/Graduate Program Mix peer group reports 25th percentile = \$379 and 50th percentile = \$290,  
Since \$247 falls between \$239 and \$290, the quartile placement for MSU is the 26 to 50 quartile.
- (4) Finally, the Highest Degree Awarded peer group calculates the 25th percentile = \$229, and the 50th percentile = \$271.  
Since \$247 falls between \$229 and \$271, the quartile placement for MSU is the 26 to 50 quartile.

The following data represents calculated average cost quartiles per full-time equivalent student enrollment (FTE) for MSU comparison groups. The data provides a reference for the data provided in Table 10. The data in Table 10 is placed in quartile columns based on the values provided here.

**For example:**

- (1) The Art & Design Department average cost to produce 1 credit hour is reported on Table 10 as \$7,315.  
On Table 10, this value places them in the 26 to 50 peer quartile group for all three comparison groups.
- (2) In the Art & Design Department Carnegie Classification columns below, the 25th percentile value = \$6,763, and the 50th percentile value = \$8,100.  
Since \$7,315 falls between \$6,763 and \$8,100 the quartile placement for MSU is the 26 to 50 quartile.
- (3) Furthermore, the Undergraduation/Graduate Program Mix peer group reports 25th percentile = \$7,016 and 50th percentile = \$8,384.  
Since \$7,315 falls between \$7,016 and \$8,384, the quartile placement for MSU is the 26 to 50.
- (4) Finally, the Highest Degree Awarded peer group calculates the 25th percentile = \$6,883, and the 50th percentile = \$8,140.  
Since \$7,315 falls between \$6,883 and \$8,140, the quartile placement for MSU is the 26 to 50 quartile.

Sub-unit expenses were apportioned according to faculty distribution.
<b>Cost per Student Credit Hour (SCH):</b>	Total expenses for the discipline divided by total SCH taught by discipline faculty. Costs based on Operating Budget-to-Actual Expense Category Summary Report. Faculty were assigned to disciplines and sub-units based on area of highest number of SCH. Sub-unit expenses were apportioned according to faculty distribution.
<b>Faculty type:</b>	<p>Four categories of faculty type are used to report information for the National Study of Instructional Costs and Productivity conducted by the University of Delaware. Faculty types are organized based on tenure status and contract length. Academic administrators (department heads, deans, and associate deans) have been excluded from the faculty types. Faculty on sabbatical are included.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Tenured\Tenure-Track Faculty (or tenure/tenure eligible) includes all faculty appointed to tenured or tenure-track positions.</li> <li>2. Other Regular Faculty (or tenure ineligible) includes all full-time instructional faculty not tenure eligible such as clinical faculty, visiting faculty, and most instructors. Few faculty in this category are above the rank of instructor.</li> <li>3. Supplemental Faculty (or per course) includes all faculty with no regular instructional appointment. This group includes per-course (appointed to teach on a course-by-course basis), Academic Administrators, or any member of the professional staff whose primary function is something other than instruction. These faculty are also known as time-limited.</li> <li>4. Graduate Teaching Assistant type includes all graduate students who are appointed to teach.</li> </ol>

<b>FTE faculty:</b>	A calculation in which full-time individuals are considered to be 1.00 FTE and part-time personnel, such as per course faculty, are assigned an FTE of 0.25 for each 3 credit hour course taught; a graduate teaching assistant is assigned an FTE of 0.5. Note: Faculty on sabbatical are included, and FTE faculty calculations are adjusted to reflect departmental splits and grant buy-outs. Per Delaware Study guidelines, the Department of Defense and Strategic Studies, the Master of Public Health, Military Science, and interdisciplinary programs are not reported.

<b>FTE student:</b>	The equivalent of one student carrying a standard student load in accordance with institutional standards. For undergraduate students, a standard student load for a 16-week semester is 15 hours. For master's students, a standard load is 12 hours, and for doctoral students, a standard load is 9 hours.
<b>Graduate division course level:</b>	Includes course number series 600 and higher.
<b>Highest degree awarded productivity comparisons:</b>	Comparisons based on the highest degree awarded per discipline by each participating institution. The report here provides data for each discipline for institutions with highest degrees awarded comparable to MSU.
<b>Lower division course level:</b>	Includes course number series 000 to 299.
<b>n/a:</b>	Either the MSU Faculty FTE for the category is zero and comparisons are not applicable or comparison data is not available.

<b>Sections Taught Protocol Guidelines:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. African American Studies, Gender Studies, misc other courses are usually taught by faculty members who are paid as a part of their regular departments and their salaries are included with their department. These sections are reported with the instructors in the department paying the instructor.</li><li>2. China campus, dual credit high school, study away and exit exams are not counted.</li><li>3. Courses are counted as lower, upper, or graduate sections based on which has the majority of students.</li><li>4. Cross-listed courses are counted only once based on the time/location/instructor based on highest enrollment.</li><li>5. Ed Advisement, Educational Field Experience are not included in section count.</li><li>6. GEP &amp; UHC (honors) courses are counted in the department to which the faculty member belongs and are added to faculty member's total.</li><li>7. IDS courses are not counted because they are paid for from non-departmental budgets.</li><li>8. Individualized instruction arranged courses (music lessons, small ensembles, graduate recital) are not included in the section count, only counted as credit hours.</li><li>9. IVID sections are only counted as separate sections if an instructor is present.</li><li>10. Military Science courses are not counted since they are not taught by university faculty.</li><li>11. Music ensemble courses which are taught as one class (usually performing ensembles such as choir, orchestra, band) with multiple course numbers are counted as one section for the instructor.</li><li>12. Sections not online that do not have a meeting time and place such as Arranged are not counted.</li><li>13. Tracking courses are not counted.</li><li>14. All other courses not mentioned here are included in section count.</li></ol>
<b>Student credit hours (SCH):</b>	<p>A unit of measure that represents one student engaged in an activity for which one hour of credit toward a degree or certificate is granted upon successful completion.
