


# **Graduate Assistants**

# **ACADEMIC SUPPORT CLASS**

Cohort 5 - Community Engagement and Disability Advocacy: Students are currently working on a volunteer project and will be completing community service of their choice. They have begun to learn and discuss disability rights and advocacy. Part of this learning has been through watching and discussing the documentary, Crip Camp.

Cohort 6 - Time and Money Management:
